


Family Faith Steps

This unit teaches preschoolers some of the things God gives us that we need to live. This month, your child will learn the following stories:

- God provides food for the people (Exodus 16:11-18; Numbers 11:7-8).
- Samuel is raised by caring adults (1 Samuel 1:20, 26-27; 2:18-19, 26).
- God gives water for the people (Exodus 17:1-6).
- God provides for all our needs (Genesis 1:29; 2:8-10, 15, 18; 3:20-21).

UNIT THEME: God Meets Our Needs
BIBLE MEMORY VERSE: God will meet
all your needs. Philippians 4:19





Family Time

Decorate aprons together as a family. As you make meals with the food God gives, wear your aprons to remember where the food you eat comes from.

Use old magazines to make a collage of things that we need. On the poster, write the memory verse for this unit, “God will meet all your needs.” Philippians 4:19.

Look for ways to help meet others’ needs in your family, community, and around the world. Involve your preschooler as much as possible and talk about how God uses others to meet our needs.

Bible Time

Relate daily happenings to show that all good things come from God. For instance, if your child is drinking water because he is thirsty, you could say, “Isn’t it good that God gives us water? God knows what we need when we are thirsty.”

Action Rhyme

Use this action rhyme to help your child learn the Unit Memory Verse. The memory verse is in bold.

Someone feeds you everyday.

(Pretend to eat.)

Someone teaches you to pray

(Fold hands as if praying.)

Someone holds you when you’re afraid.

(Wrap your arms around yourself.)

For **God will meet all your needs.**

(Clap hands above your head.)

Thank God for the food at each meal. Start with a simple prayer so your young child can learn to pray. When your child has more confidence, all family members may want to take turns saying short prayers in their own words.
